The Cedar Rapids Metro Economic Alliance and Greater Iowa City, Inc. annually recommend and support positions on key policy issues affecting our region and state's economic growth. These positions and recommendations are made with significant input from our combined 2,000 members, investors, partners, and community stakeholders.

GOAL: Invest in Talent Development

A strong education system that aligns with the needs of the business community is critical to meeting our region's workforce needs. Iowa must support innovative education initiatives and programs that develop talent, including increasing funding for aviation workforce development.

Our region has rich origins in aviation innovation that continue today with regional higher education institutions powering the Aviation Campus at the Eastern Iowa Airport (CID). We must support continued funding for these initiatives and Iower financial barriers to the aviation profession. Combining the right workforce with shovel-ready property at CID will provide significant opportunity for high-quality aviation business development and employment.

We must also continue expanding employer involvement in developing workforce programs that align with PK-12, community colleges, universities, and private institutions to build a talent pipeline and attract the best and brightest to Iowa.

Additionally, access to quality education systems from early childhood and K-12 to postsecondary education and on-the-job training is vital to lowa's economic growth. As we continue strategies that increase our state's population, we must have policies that promote employment expansion, income growth, and wealth development for all residents.
