TUITION & FUNDING

Employers or sponsoring organization must be members for the full duration of the program. For example, for those applying for the Class of 2026, the employer or sponsoring organization must be a member of the Economic Alliance for both 2025 and 2026. **Refund Policy:** No tuition refunds are issued unless an alternate candidate is derived from the selection committee process is substituted prior to July 17, 2025.
