Project Amendment to the Transportation Improvement Program

Cedar Rapids – The Corridor Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) is providing the public an opportunity to comment on a proposed amendment to the Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) for the City of Cedar Rapids’ National Electric Vehicle Infrastructure (NEVI) Project. This amendment will include federal funding that was awarded to the City of Cedar Rapids in the TIP.

The TIP is the annual capital budget for the Corridor MPO. The TIP is a four-year planning document that identifies planned transportation projects within the Corridor MPO's planning boundary that are expected to utilize federal-aid funds (instead of local or private funds). The MPO provides federal funding to our member jurisdictions for roadway, trail, and transit construction or capital projects. Comments are being solicited on the Corridor MPO’s website. Comments will be shared with our Policy Board at their next meeting, where they will also take action to consider approval of these amendments.

All members of the public are welcome to comment. This press release has opened a 30-day public comment period, and comments must be received by MPO staff on or before *Thursday, January 15, 2026*.
